## **Plastic Recycling**

We are participating in a program provided by CRDC, a new recycling facility in York.

They accept ALL plastics, even the ones that are not accepted by your local trash collectors.

But **ONLY** plastics....no glass or metal

#1 – Soft drink & water bottles, microwave food trays, mouthwash bottles

#2 – Laundry detergent bottles, milk, water & juice jugs

#3 – Shampoo & cleaning bottles, clamshell food containers, plastic wrap

#4 – Squeezable bottles, bread bags, frozen food bags, plastic bags

#5 – Medicine bottles, yogurt containers, bottle caps, margarine tubs

#6 – Food trays, cups, egg containers, carry-out containers

#7 – 3 and 5 gallon reusable water jugs, CD cases, sunglasses

\*\* Plastic cups, straws, shopping bags, potato chip packets

\*\* ANYTHING PLASTIC

\*\* Even STYROFOAM

THE ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY AND CLEAN

Collect your items in a plastic bag and bring them with you when we are at Christ UCC.

The garage at the rear of the church will be unlocked for you to drop off your bags.

Both the entrance door and the overhead door in the alley will be open.
